WITNESSETH, That said Grantor, for and in consideration of the sum of

One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00), and other good and valuable considerations, to it in hand paid by the Grantee, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does hereby grant, bargain, quitclaim and convey unto the Grantee and its assigns an easement and road right-of-way over and across the following described lands of the Grantor situated in the County of Beltrami, State of Minnesota, to wit:

NELSW of Section 34, Township 147 North, Range 30 West of the Fifth Principal Meridian, Said right-of-way being a strip of land thirty-three (33) feet wide extending sixteen and one-half (162) feet on either side of and adjacent to the centerline.

The exact location of the centerline, including courses and distances, is particularly set forth in the ensuing description:

Beginning at a point on the west boundary line of the NELSWI, Section 34, which point is located south 440 feet from the northwest corner of said NELSWI; thence along the arc of 102° 25' curve right 182.2 feet (chord distance and bearing 180.7 feet - S. 86° 27' E.); thence S. 73° 30' E. 1,178.9 feet to the point of ending on the east boundary line of NELSWI. All timber cut in clearing for or maintaining the right-of-way shall be cut in 100 inch lengths and piled in convenient piles along the road right-of-way. Brush shall be disposed of in such a manner as to not create a fire hazard.

This grant shall be effective only so long as said easement and right-of-way shall actually be used by the Grantee and its assigns for the purpose above specified, and all rights hereunder shall revert to the owner of the land as soon as said use thereof shall be abandoned and discontinued.
